PICK UP & DROP OFF

I have arranged a Charter Bus to pick us up at Harvest and transport us to camp. It is roughly a 2 hr. 40 min. Commute to Old Oak Ranch, Sonora.

*If your child is prone to motion sickness and requires any form of medication, we recommend it! The road gets windy as we head up the mountain.

On Monday, June 12th, we will all meet at harvest no later than 10:30 am and will depart around 11:30 am. We are aiming to be at the campsite around 2:30 pm. Feel free to text or call your students to make sure we arrived safely.

On Thursday, June 15th we will depart from camp at 10:00 am and head straight to Harvest. We are aiming to arrive at Harvest around 12:40 pm. We will not be stopping for lunch on the way home, so if your child needs a snack, we recommend that you pack one.

If there is any delay, I will do my best to communicate with you via group text.

Pack any red clothing/accessories you may have!

WHAT TO BRING

- Warm clothes for nighttime (Our evening/night services will be outside – so pack warm!)

- Towels (One for the bathroom and one for water activities)
- Modest Swimsuit (No speedos for men, two-piece suits need to be covered by a big/ baggy dark shirt for ladies)
- Sleeping Bag or Sheets & Blanket (An extra blanket is always a good idea!)
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Extra clothes that can get messy.
- Close-toed shoes are a must. Bring sandals if you like.
- Spending money (Optional for camp store/Camp gear/Snacks/ and Activities)
- A smile and a good attitude!

MHAT NOT TO BRING

DO NOT BRING:

- Any medication that isn't pre-approved by Pastor Josh
- Alcohol/Drugs
- Weapons, firearms, or explosives of any kind
- Inappropriate games, music, entertainment, etc.
- Bad Attitude/Gossiping/Argumentative-Dividing Spirit
